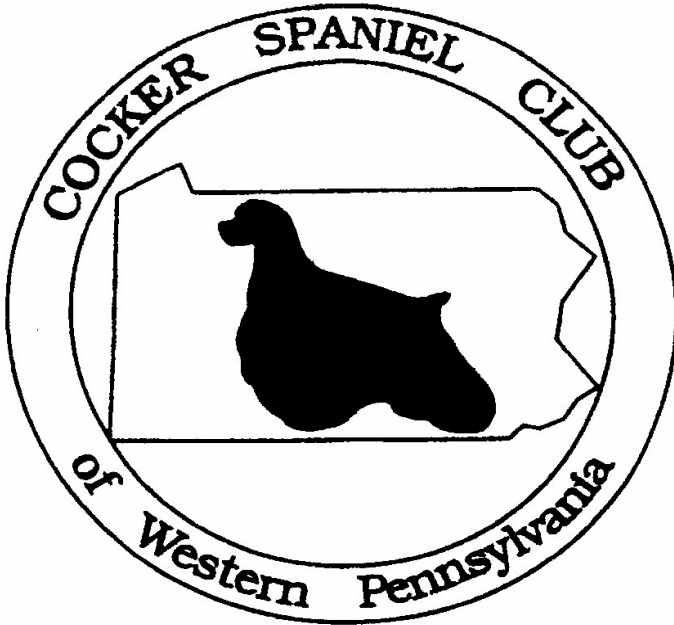

All Regular Classes are divided by sex and are offered for only BLACK, ASCOB & PARTI-COLOR varieties of Cocker Spaniels.

AMATEUR-OWNER-HANDLER CLASS

(effective as of 1/1/2009) Chapter 3, Section 7 - The Amateur-Owner-Handler Class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

BEST OF VARIETY COMPETITION

Dogs eligible for this competition include: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records.

NONREGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES OF COCKER SPANIELS:

Veteran Classes – Class for dogs & class for bitches who are seven (7) years & over. Winners from these classes will be eligible to compete for BEST OF VARIETY. Entry fee is \$13

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES FOR COCKER SPANIELS:

The Sweepstakes is open to all Cocker Spaniels (Black, ASCOB & Parti-Color) who are 6 months and under 12 months of age on the day of the show. Classes for 6-9 and 9-12. Entry fee is \$13

STRIPPED DOWN SWEEPSTAKES:

Class for dogs & class for bitches (all varieties shown together). Entry fee is \$13

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP:

Novice Junior, Novice Intermediate, Novice Senior, Open Junior, Open Intermediate, Open Senior.

REGULAR OBEDIENCE:

Novice A, Novice B, Open A, Open B, Utility A, Utility B,

NONREGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES: Pre-Novice, Graduate Novice, Graduate Open, Versatility

ALL BREED RALLY: Novice A, Novice B, Advanced A, Advanced B, Excellent A, Excellent B

OBEDIENCE TRIAL CLASSES

- Qualifying Score Required for All Prizes
- “Dog” means either sex
- Bitches that come in season – after closing of entries may receive a full refund of entry fee if certification from a Veterinarian is received by the Superintendent/show secretary before the judging begins on the day of the trial.
- A Dark Green Qualifying Score Ribbon will be awarded to each dog receiving a qualifying score.

RALLY CLASSES

- Qualifying Score Required for All Prizes
- “Dog” means either sex
- Move-ups will be allowed
- Bitches that come in season – after closing of entries may receive a full refund of entry fee if certification from a Veterinarian is received by the Superintendent/show secretary before the judging begins on the day of the trial.
- A Dark Green Qualifying Score Ribbon will be awarded to each dog receiving a qualifying score.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

- The Sweepstakes is open to all AKC Cocker Spaniels (Black, ASCOB & Parti-Color) who are 6 months and under 12 months of age on the day of the show.
- Classes will be divided by variety and by ages as follows
 - 6 months and under 9 months of age dogs
 - 9 months and under 12 months of age dogs
 - 6 months and under 9 months of age bitches
 - 9 months and under 12 months of age bitches
- Indicate age division under regular class and “Puppy Sweepstakes” under Additional Classes.
- Entry fee is \$13.00
- All dogs entered in Puppy Sweepstakes must also be entered in a Regular Class at the Cocker Spaniel Club of Western Pennsylvania Specialty.
- PRIZE MONEY: After 35% has been deducted by the Club for expenses, the remainder will be divided as follows:
 - Best in Puppy Sweepstakes – 30%
 - Best of Opposite Sex to Puppy Best In Sweeps – 10%
 - Best of Variety in Puppy Sweeps – 30% (divided)
 - Best of Opposite Sex to BOV in Puppy Sweeps – 20% (divided)
 - First in each Class – 10% (divided by the total number of classes)

STRIPPED DOWN SWEEPSTAKES

- This Stripped Down Competition is open to any AKC Cocker Spaniel dog or bitch. Length of hair cannot be longer than 2" on any portion of the body, with the exception of the ears where there will be no length requirement. **This requirement will be STRICTLY enforced.**
- The judging will be conducted by the Puppy Sweepstakes Judge. Judging will begin immediately after the completion of the Puppy Sweepstakes and prior to the start of regular class judging.
- All varieties of dogs will be judged first as one class, and then all varieties of bitches will be judged as the second class. The winners of those two respective classes will compete for Best in Stripped Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Stripped Sweepstakes.
- Entrants in this special competition will not be required to compete for Best of Variety. The fee for this class will be \$13.00. Indicate "Stripped" on the regular entry form under additional classes.
- **PRIZE MONEY** After 35% has been deducted by the Club for expenses, the remainder will be divided as follows:
 - Best in Stripped Down Sweepstakes – 35%
 - Best of Opposite Sex to Best In Stripped Down Sweeps – 30%

- 1.(variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniels (Black, ASCOB, Parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in.; over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (Longhaired, Smooth, Wirehaired), Bull Terriers (Colored, White), Manchester Terriers (Standard, Toy), Chihuahuas (Smooth Coat, Long Coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (Toy, Miniature, Standard), Collies (Rough, Smooth).

The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competitions is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog competed the requirements for a championship.
- 3.(Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list, if the dog show class in which you are entering you dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- 4.A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on the entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 14, Section 3.)
- 5.Mixed Breed dogs entering Agility, Obedience and Rally trials should mark Breed as "MIXED BREED." Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam, information should remain blank for mixed breed entrants/

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
